



Trainer Requirements

Electronic Timing

Certified and worked in that position a minimum of 12 sessions, 6 of which must be at a meet heavy in BC swimmers.

Sessions worked must be at OSI sanctioned meets. High school and college meets do not apply.

Must have consistently worked at more than one pool.

Endorsements from Area Officials Chair or Electronic Timing Chair and/or at least 2 other ET trainers.

Attend initial trainer clinic.

Stroke and Turn

Certified and worked in that position a minimum of 12 sessions, 6 of which must be at a meet heavy in BC swimmers.

Sessions worked must be at OSI sanctioned meets. High school and college meets do not apply.

Must have consistently worked at more than one pool.

Endorsements from Area Officials Chair or one referee.

Attend initial trainer clinic.

Starter

Certified and worked in that position a minimum of 12 sessions, 6 of which must be at a meet heavy in BC swimmers.

Sessions worked must be at OSI sanctioned meets. High school and college meets do not apply.

Must have consistently worked at more than one pool.

Endorsements from Area Officials Chair or OSI Officials Chair or one referee.

Must be a Stroke and Turn Trainer.

Referee

Certified and worked in that position a minimum of 20 sessions. Meet referee, deck referee, and administrative referee positions apply.

Sessions worked must be at OSI sanctioned meets. High school and college meets do not apply.

Must have consistently worked at more than one pool.

Endorsements from Area Officials Chair or OSI Officials Chair and one referee.

Must be a Stroke and Turn and Starter trainer.

Certification log and endorsements must be submitted to the master trainer prior to attending clinic.

Trainer Recertification

For all positions – Participate in a minimum of four training opportunities within a recertification period: clinics; on deck training; stroke briefings.
