Eligibility: Swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming. No on deck meet registration shall be permitted.

Facility: Covered indoor 6 LANE 25 yrd pool. Pool depth is 10 ft to 3 ½ ft. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2(c)4.

Daktronics timing system.

Entries:

With submission of entries, the coach/team representative attests that all swimmers entered are registered with USA Swimming.

***Meet PRE-SEEDED ONLY * (Max of 150 athletes, priority given to those who provide officials, otherwise will be accepted in order received.)**

SATURDAY : SWIMMERS MAY ENTER [1] RELAYS AND [3]INDIVIDUAL EVENT.
SUNDAY: SWIMMERS MAY ENTER [1] RELAY AND [3] INDIVIDUAL EVENTS.

All swimmers entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. *

Rules/Safety: Current USA Swimming and Oregon Swimming rules will apply during the meet. Oregon Swimming Safety Guidelines & Warm-up procedure will be in effect and strictly enforced.
All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

Restrictions: No tobacco products, no alcoholic beverages, no glass containers are allowed. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Deck changing is prohibited. Photography is not allowed behind the blocks during the start of a race or relay exchange. Operations of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pool, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.

Officials: Teams shall notify the meet director or meet referee of the availability of officials from their team to work the meet. No walk on officials will be allowed. An officials meeting will be set up by the referee (Matt Beasley), and will be scheduled prior to the meet.

Timers: Volunteers will be needed from each team.

MEET PROTOCOL: (if masks required)

- *Everyone must enter and leave through the front door of the facility.*
- *Prior to race, all athletes will need to put their face masks in a ziploc bag, behind the blocks*
- *For relays, unless you are swimming, athletes will need to remain masked until they are next to swim.*
- *After the race, athletes will remain in the pool until timers have backed up against the wall. The athletes will get out, put on their masks and exit to the east side of the pool.*
- *After the 25 -yard races, the athletes will swim back to the starting end of the pool, and get their masks. Then exit the pool to the east side.*
