Eligibility: Swimmers must be currently registered as athlete members with USA Swimming. No

swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302. No on-deck registration shall be permitted. Swimmers must be within the listed age brackets as of May 19, 2023. Coaches must display current credentials.

Entry Deadlines: Entry acceptance period begins: Noon, Thursday, April 20, 2023. We expect the meet

to fill quickly. Early entries will not be accepted. Final entry deadline is 5:00 PM,

Thursday, May 11, 2023.

Event Limit: 3 events per day exclusive of relays.

Meet Limit: Teams are accepted on a first-come basis. 4-hour limit for 12-Under morning session; meet

director and meet referee discretion on length of afternoon session. Afternoon session warmup and meet start times may be earlier depending on the size of the morning session. Actual

times for afternoon sessions will be announced on Friday, May 12, 2023.

Entry Fees: \$17.00 per swimmer surcharge (\$14 FUF; \$3 OSI surcharge) plus \$5.50 per individual event

Entries: Submit <u>long course meter times</u> only for seeding. Converted times will be accepted. 13

and over swimmers must meet time standards. No NT accepted for 12 and under sessions. Converted times will be accepted for entry. Send entries by email using Hy-Tek format. With submission of entries, the coach/team representative attests that all swimmers entered

are registered with USA Swimming, Inc.

Awards: Individual: 1st- 16th ribbons for 12 & Under session

Relay: 1st - 16th ribbons for 12 & Under session

High Point: One award, boy & girl, 8 & under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15 & over.

The age groups of combined events will be scored separately. Awards must be picked up at the end of the Sunday PM session. Awards will not be mailed after the meet.

Check-in/Scratch:

Over-swimmer starts will be used. All events swum during the Saturday and Sunday AM sessions will be pre-seeded. All events swum during the Friday, Saturday, and Sunday PM sessions will be deck seeded.

A. Deck-Seeded Events

- 1. Coaches are responsible for providing a positive check-in 45 minutes prior to the start of the meet on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday PM.
- 2. After the heats have been seeded, any swimmer who fails to compete in an individual event in which such swimmer had previously provided a positive check-in, will be barred from his or her next individual event, either that day or the next day. S/he will be permitted to participate in relay events of that day.
- 3. There is no penalty for missing a pre-seeded event or relay.
- 4. Heat sheets will be published following the positive check-in deadline.
- B. *Exceptions for failure to compete* No penalty shall apply for failure to withdraw or compete in an individual event if:
- 1. The swimmer declares a false start with the referee prior to the start of the heat in which they do not compete.

Bull Pen: A bull pen will be provided for 8 and under swimmers All other swimmers shall report

directly to their assigned lanes.

Timing: Daktronics timing system, horn start, and finish touch pads. Colorado or Daktronics timing

system with buttons or watches for 50 meter races. Results via electronic scoreboard.

Names will appear as received in meet entries.

Meetings: Officials' meetings will be held each session 60 minutes prior to the start of









competition. Coaches' meeting 15 minutes prior to the start of the meet.

Rules: Current USA Swimming, Inc. and Oregon Swimming, Inc. rules will govern this meet. No

Officials: We always appreciate the help of certified officials and trainees from other clubs. Uniform will

be white over black with black shoes. If you will be attending, please send your name and the sessions you will work to the Meet Referee at bill.shreeve1@gmail.com. Hospitality will be

provided for coaches & officials.

Timers: Each team will be assigned lane-timing duty. Sign-up sheets will be at clerk of course

Facility: Competition Pool – 50 Meters 8 lanes x 7-ft wide with 6-inch lines, Kiefer Freestyle

starting blocks with grab rails and foot chocks. Depth: 3.5 to 13 ft.

The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2(C).

Warm-up Pool: The outdoor warm up pool will be open as long as facility staff are available. If closed, 5

minute warm-up/cool down breaks will be inserted into the timeline after each even event

during the 13 and over afternoon sessions only.

Seating: Air-conditioned, sound insulated, balcony seating for 270. Only those parents who are timing

are allowed in the competition area. **SWIMMERS AND COACHES ONLY**

PLEASE, ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE POOL.

Pool Hours: The facility will be open each day from 30 minutes before the start of warmups

through the conclusion of the meet.

Safety: Oregon Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect and strictly

enforced. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or

the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

No spectators are allowed in the competition area (swimmers entered in the session, timers, officials, and coaches only.) No spectators/non-athlete adults are allowed in the locker rooms.

Absolutely NO Cell Phone use within the locker rooms.

Medical: Medical facilities available include lifeguards, an AED, and community 911 EMS.

Restrictions: No tobacco products, alcohol, or glass containers are allowed in the pool facility. Use of

audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks during individual or relay starts. No deck changing. Operations of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or









spectators are present. At the discretion of the referee and meet management, restrictions may be placed on the deck and/or spectators to comply with facility, state,

county and/or local health or capacity regulations.

Concessions: Concessions by the Corvallis Aquatic Team - snacks, drinks, and other food -

available throughout the meet

Camping: No OVERNIGHT CAMPING or RV's in the parking lots adjacent to the pool.
