Eligibility: Swimmers must currently be registered with USA Swimming. Swimmers must be within

entered age brackets as of March 6, 2023. Only swimmers from the Corvallis Aquatic

Team are eligible. No deck registration permitted.

Entry Deadline:

Entries must be received no later than noon on Monday March 6, 2023.

Entry Limit: Swimmers may enter a maximum of three individual events per session.

Meet Format &

Specifics: All events will be pre-seeded timed finals; swum mixed gender; slow to fast.

Entries:

With submission of entries, the coach/team representative attests that all swimmers

entered are registered with USA Swimming.

Awards: No awards.

Facility: Competition Pool:8 lanes, 7-ft 25-yard lanes, 30-in tilted blocks. Depth: 6ft to13 ft. Warm-

up/Cool-Down not available during the meet. The competition course has not been

certified in accordance with 104.2.2 C(4).

<u>Seating/</u> Spectators allowed in designated areas.

<u>Timing:</u> Daktronics timing system, horn start, and finish touch pads. Results via

electronic scoreboard. Names will appear as received in meet entries.

Pool Hours: The facility will be open to the public during the competition. Participants may not enter

the facility prior to their scheduled warm-up time to stay in line with occupancy limits.

<u>Times:</u> Warmups and competition will begin <u>no earlier</u> than the posted times below.

Rules: Current USA Swimming and Oregon Swimming Inc. rules, will govern this meet.

MAAPP: All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention

Policy ("MAAPP") and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a

condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

Tech Suits: As of September 1, 2020, no Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA

Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed

meet.

Safety: Current Oregon Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect

and strictly enforced.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or

the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Medical services available: Facility staff and lifeguards on duty, access to first responders via

911.

Restrictions: The deck is restricted to athletes entered in the meet, coaches with athletes entered in the

meet, meet staff, and meet officials and facility employees. No spectators except meet volunteers and timers may access the pool deck. No glass containers, tobacco products, or alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool facility. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Cell phones and photography are not allowed behind the blocks. Deck changing is prohibited. Operations of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time

athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
