FORMAT:	All sessions will be timed finals and swum mixed gender and age. All events 500 and longer will be deck seeded and swum fast to slow. Relays will be deck seeded. All other individual events will be pre-seeded and swum slow to fast. Coaches are encouraged to report scratches.
	Positive check-in for events 500 or longer and the relays will be 30 Minutes after the start of warm-ups.

	 Relay events will be scored and awarded through 8th place as 26-22-20-18-16-14-12-10
RESTRICTIONS:	No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet. Tobacco, non-tobacco, vapor products of any kind, alcoholic beverages, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue. NO SHAVING PERMITTED in the venue. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Deck changing is prohibited. Please change in designated changing areas or locker rooms only. Photography is not allowed behind the blocks at any time during the meet. Operations of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pool, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
SAFETY:	Oregon Swimming Safety Rules and Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
