<u>Sanction:</u> In applying for this sanction, the Corvallis Aquatic Team agrees to comply and to enforce all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Oregon Swimming, the State of Oregon, and the City of Corvallis.

In granting this sanction, it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, Oregon Swimming, and the Corvallis Aquatic Team shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of this event.

**Host:** Corvallis Aquatic Team

**Host Facility:** Osborn Aquatic Center, 1940 NW Highland Dr., Corvallis OR 97330

**Eligibility:** Swimmers must currently be registered with USA Swimming as a member of one of the invited teams. Swimmers must be within entered age brackets as of June 3, 2023. No deck registration shall be permitted.

Entry Deadline: Entries open on May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023 at noon and must be received no later than **noon** on Monday, May 22<sup>nd</sup> 2023. No on-deck registration will be permitted.

**Entry Limit:** Swimmers may enter a maximum of two individual events on Saturday and three individual events on Sunday

<u>Meet Format & Specifics</u>: The meet will be run in LCM. The 800 Freestyle will be deck seeded. All other events will be pre-seeded timed finals and swum as mixed gender. Age limits/guidelines are designated on pages 4-5 (Order of Events). Over swimmer starts will be used.

Each session will be limited to no more than 4 hours. Entries may be limited to comply with these time limits.

Entry Fees: \$13/swimmer (\$3 OSI surcharge, \$10 Osborn facility use fee) \$4.5 Individual entry fee per event

<u>Entries:</u> Please submit a Hytek entry file to brandon@corvallisaquaticteam.org. With submission of entries, the coach/team representative attests that all swimmers entered are registered with USA Swimming. Entries are due at noon on Monday May 22<sup>nd</sup>.

**Awards:** No awards.

<u>Facility:</u> Competition Pool:8 lanes, 7-ft 50-meter lanes, 30-in tilted blocks. Depth: 3.5ft to13 ft. Warm-up/Cool-Down: Outdoor 25 meter pool, 6 lanes. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2 C(4).

**Seating:** Spectator seating is limited to the balcony and the deck on the non-competition end of the pool.

<u>Timing:</u> Daktronics timing system, horn start, and finish touch pads. Results via electronic scoreboard. Names will appear as received in meet entries.

**<u>Pool Hours:</u>** The facility will not be open to the public during the competition. Participants may not enter the facility prior to the scheduled warm-up time.

<u>Times:</u> Warm ups and the meet will begin <u>no earlier</u> than the posted times below. Actual start times will be announced via email and posted on the CAT website as soon as entries are complete.

Rules: Current USA Swimming and Oregon Swimming Inc. rules, will govern this meet.

MAAPP: All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP") and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

<u>Tech Suits:</u> As of September 1, 2020, no Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.

<u>Safety:</u>Current Oregon Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect and strictly enforced.

It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of this event.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

**Medical:** Medical facilities available include lifeguards, an AED, and community 911 EMS.

Restrictions: The deck is restricted to athletes entered in the meet, coaches with athletes entered in the meet, meet staff, meet officials, and facility employees. No spectators except meet volunteers and timers may access the pool deck. No glass containers, tobacco products, or alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool facility. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Cell phones and photography are not allowed behind the blocks. Deck changing is prohibited. Operations of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

<u>Meetings:</u> Official's meeting will be held at the start of warm ups. Time to be announced. Coach's meeting will be held 15 minutes before the start of the meet. Time to be announced.

<u>Timers:</u> The meet will be operated with 2 timers per lane. Each team will be responsible for providing multiple timers. Lane assignments will be sent out after entries are submitted.
