In granting this sanction, it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of this event.
- Host:** **David Douglas Aquatics Club / Legacy Aquatics**
- Host Facility:** David Douglas Aquatics Center, 13030 SE Taylor Ct. Portland, OR 97233
- Eligibility:** Swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, and must be within the listed age brackets as of May 20, 2023. No on-deck registration shall be permitted.
- Entry Deadline:** Final entry deadline is 8:00 pm on **Monday May 15th, 2023**, and may close sooner if the meet limit is reached. Team Manager Event file will be available on the DDAC & OSI website.
- Event Limit:** 3 individual events per meet session
- Meet Limit:** Entries are accepted on a first-come basis. Swimmer capacity TBD by the Meet Director & Meet Referee. A four hour limit for each session will be strictly enforced.
- Entry Fees:** \$18.00 per swimmer surcharge (includes \$3 OSI fee and \$15.00 facility use fee)
\$2.00 per individual event (includes .50 OSI fee)

YARD TIMES only for seeding. With submission of entries, the coach-team representative attests that all swimmers entered are registered with USA Swimming.
- Meet Format:** All events will be swum as timed finals. Relief breaks in the competition may be added at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Flyover starts may be used.
- Facility:** Competition Pool – eight lanes, 7-ft lanes, 25 Yard pool. Depth: The starting block end is 9 feet, the turn end is 3.5 feet. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2 C(4).
- Seating:** Only parents who are timing are allowed in the starting area. Parent Spectator Area will be in the colored bleachers, the metal bleachers are for swimmers only.
- Timing:** Daktronics timing system, horn start, and finish touch pads. Results via electronic scoreboard.
- Each team will be given lane timing assignments based on the number of swimmers entered, sign-ups will be on the wall behind the start area.

Pool Hours: Pool will be open to meet participants from 7:00 AM until the conclusion of the meet.

Awards: Trophies: 1st-12th place in each age group (8&U, 9-10, 11-12, 13&Over). Swimmers must compete in all 6 events to be eligible for a trophy.
Trophy presentation will follow the conclusion of Sunday's competition & inter-tube relays.

Scoring: Accumulated time from all 6 events will decide top finishers for each age group. Disqualifications in an event will add 60 seconds to swimmer's time. Accumulated scores will be posted at the conclusion of Saturdays & Sundays events & on the DDAC website.

Meetings: Officials meeting will be held approximately 60 minutes prior to start of each session. Coaches meeting will be held 15 minutes prior to start of each session.

Concessions: Concession items will be provided at facility, located outside the pool area.

Parking/Camping: Multiple parking lots are available around the Aquatics Center. There is no camping or RV Parking.

Rules: Current USA Swimming and Oregon Swimming, Inc. rules will govern this meet.

Safety/Restriction: Current Oregon Swimming Safety Guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect. No tobacco products, alcohol, or glass containers are allowed in the facility. Shaving is not allowed in the venue. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Deck changing is prohibited. The use of cell phones or photography equipment behind the blocks is not allowed at any time.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts from the blocks or on the deck, otherwise the swimmer must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Unaccompanied swimmers must be assigned a coach BEFORE the swimmer may enter the water for warm-ups or competition. It is the swimmer's responsibility to arrange, please notify the Meet Director or Referee if assistance is needed.

Medical Info: David Douglas Aquatic Center Lifeguards with access to AED, first aid and medical supplies will be available for any injury or medical emergency. 911 will be utilized as necessary.

- MAAPP:** All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
- Tech Suits:** No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.
- Officials:** To ensure the sanction of this event and the validity of the competitor swim times, teams must provide certified officials. Officials need to email the meet referee before Wed 5/10 their declaration of officiating the event. Certification of officials must be on display while they are officiating the meet.
- Hospitality:** Hospitality Room will be provided for coaches and officials throughout the meet in the pool lobby office.
