Pool depth varies from $6^{\prime} 7$ " to $12^{\prime}$ at deep end and $3^{\prime} 6^{\prime \prime}$ at shallow end. Facility has steps for adaptive swimmers. The pool does not have a ramp. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Unsupervised playground and splash park are available outside the pool fence. |

(2) individual events plus one relay on Friday night. Swimmers may enter a maximum of three
